NEGTC Nebraska Electric Generation & Transmission Cooperative
Columbus, NE

Wholesale Power Supply - Deals with Nebraska Public Power District on Rates and Agreements that affect the Districts - 24 members. Also compiles Power Requirements and Irrigation Studies of the member Districts into 1 study for RUS. The G&T is a member of Midwest Electric Consumers Association, Inc. Watch dog of National Public Power Legislation and Rates. Supported by monthly assessments based on kWh purchases.

NRE Coop Nebraska Rural Electric Cooperative

Fault Finding Van Cooperative. Van is stationed at Battle Creek and dispatched to member Districts on a need basis. Charges are assessed based on mileage and hours utilized.

State Agency to oversee Public Power in Nebraska. No rate setting authority but has authority on territorial boundaries and rights to serve.

Public Service Commission

State Agency to oversee new line construction.

NPA Nebraska Power Association

Formed as an entity in Nebraska to promote Public Power and brings municipals, public power districts and wholesale suppliers into one organization. Recently completed a study on power in Nebraska for State Legislature.

NPPD Nebraska Public Power District

Generation Transmission and Distribution Utility.
Power supplier for the Nebraska Elec. G & T. Serves portions of State of Nebraska at retail as well as wholesale.

Tri-State Generation and Transmission
Denver, CO

Serves portions of Western Nebraska at wholesale. Similar to NPPD.
