POLICY# 3110

RATE SCHEDULE: IDLE SERVICE POLICY (I.S.P.)

When an existing electric power line and service is no longer being used, the owner may elect to pay an idle service charge to maintain the electric service for future use.

The District, at its discretion, may remove its equipment and facilities when no revenue is being paid to the District under any of the District's existing rate schedules.

If the electric line and facilities are removed and the same owner or owners request electric service in substantially the same location, the owners shall pay the cost of reconstruction of the necessary facilities based on the current construction costs.

IDLE SERVICE RATES FOR OVERHEAD LINES:

Annual fee per pole for single phase line (*see Fee Schedule 3500.3110-A*).

Annual fee per pole for three phase line (*see Fee Schedule 3500.3110-B*).

Minimum Annual Fee (*see Fee Schedule 3500.3110-C*).

Maximum Annual Fee (*see Fee Schedule 3500.3110-D*).

These charges will be subject to any local or state taxes. Billing shall be made on a calendar year basis.

The Idle Service charge shall be calculated on all electric power line required to maintain the service, back to the point of attachment to a feeder line or line of joint use.

Payment of the Idle Service rate does not entitle owner to receive any electric energy, and payment of current charges for reconnection, transformer and meter installation will be required upon request for service by the owner.
