

ELKHORN RURAL PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT**POLICY #3220****POLICY ON REPLACEMENT OF SECONDARY UNDERGROUND WIRE
TO IRRIGATION WELLS AND CENTER PIVOTS**

The District will require consumer to pay for conduit only, on section of wire replaced due to bad wire. The District will furnish the labor and wire for replacement.

If the consumer wishes to replace the remaining portion of the service (existing good wire) with new wire and conduit, to provide a more reliable service, the District will share the costs equally with the consumer on that portion that is not faulty.

UPRATING UNDERGROUND WIRES

If the customer chooses to uprate the underground wire to larger conductors when underground is faulty, the District will allow the credit, that would be allowed for replacement of equal size wire, towards the current aid-for-construction of the wire to be installed.

This policy (#3220) shall be automatically rescinded on November 30, 2012, as per Resolution 2009-09, adopted June 9, 2009.
