

**ELKHORN RURAL PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT****POLICY #3380****POLICY ON MOVING BUILDINGS THRU LINES**

It shall be a policy of the District that all firms engaged in moving buildings through the power lines of the Elkhorn Rural Public Power District be required to deposit an amount equal to the estimated amount of charges, based on the time and mileage in advance of the time they anticipate moving the building through said power lines. Building move routes must be selected at least five (5) working days prior to the actual moving of the building. 48 hours (2 business days) notification is requested before the move actually takes place, but in no instance will a move be undertaken with less than 24 hours prior notice.

Labor and equipment charges will begin from the time that the crews are dispatched to the job and will end at the time that they arrive back at the office or next job site.

If during the move, it appears charges will be significantly more than the deposited amount, due to unforeseen difficulties, the customer will be notified and an additional deposit will be required prior to completion of the move.

That portion of deposit in excess of actual costs (if any) will be refunded as soon as possible.
