URBAN COMMERCIAL GENERAL SERVICE-SINGLE & THREE PHASE

AVAILABLE: In the lease towns of Hadar, Clearwater, Elgin and Ewing served by the District.

APPLICABLE: To commercial and nonresidential establishments for lighting, heating, and power purposes where all service is taken through a single meter at one location, and where the Customer's peak demand does not exceed 100 KW during any two summer months or 200 KW in any two months of a 12-consecutive month period. However, any commercial Customer with a load factor of at least 250 kWh/KW and either: (1) a demand greater than 50KW, or (2) consumption greater than 15,000 kWh during any three months of a 12-consecutive month period shall have the option of being billed under the General Service Demand Rate.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE: AC, 60 hertz, single-phase or three-phase, at any of the District's standard primary and secondary distribution voltages.

FACILITIES CHARGE: Single Phase \$32.00 per month
Three Phase \$51.00 per month

DEMAND CHARGE: \$2.50 per KW

ENERGY CHARGE: Winter-October 1st to May 31st
Summer-June 1st to September 30th

The above rates are subject to the Gross Revenue Tax, Lease Payment, and Sales Tax as applicable.

Gross Revenue Tax is paid to the County.

Lease Payment is made to the Village or City.

Sales Tax is paid to the State and/or Village or City.

MINIMUM BILL: Facilities Charge

TERMS OF PAYMENT: Bills are due and payable upon receipt and delinquent if not paid by due date.

FLUCTUATING LOADS: Customers operating equipment having a highly fluctuating or large instantaneous demand such as welders and x-ray machines shall be required to pay all non-betterment cost of isolating the load from the balance of the District's system so that the load will not unduly interfere with service on the District's lines. In addition, customers who fail to provide adequate corrective equipment shall be required to own and maintain their own transformers.

URBAN COMMERCIAL GENERAL SERVICE-THREE PHASE

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT: The rates set forth in this schedule are based on the maintenance by the customer of a power factor of not less than 90% at all times. If it is determined by test that the power factor at the time of the customer's peak load is less than 90%, the District at its option may correct the power factor of the customer's load at the expense of the customer.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Service will be furnished under the District's General Terms and Conditions.
2. Extensions made for service under this schedule are subject to the provisions of the District's rules governing Extension of Service and Facilities.
