TOTAL ELECTRIC HEATING RIDER

AVAILABLE: In the general area served by the district for the heating period of October 1st to May 31st.

APPLICABLE: To customers taking service under the District's Residential or Rural Residential rates where permanently installed space heating equipment and water heating is in regular use to supply the entire space heating requirements of the normal living areas of the home.

FACILITIES CHARGE: Facilities charge will be as provided on the rate schedule regularly applicable to this service.

DEMAND CHARGE: Demand charge will be billed at the rate regularly applicable to such service.

ENERGY CHARGE: First 1,000 kWh for single phase and first 1,100 kWh for three phase per month used will be billed at the rate regularly applicable to such service.

\$0.06350 Per kWh for the next 4,000 kilowatt-hour used.

Excess kWh used per month will be billed at the rate regularly applicable to such service over 5,000 kWh for single phase or 5,100 kWh for three phase.

The above rates are subject to the Gross Revenue Tax, Lease Payment, and Sales Tax as applicable.

Gross Revenue Tax is paid to the County.

Lease Payment is paid to the Village or City.

Sales Tax is paid to the State and/or Village or City.

MINIMUM BILL: Minimum bill will be as provided on the rate schedule regularly applicable to this service.

TERMS OF PAYMENT: Bills are due and payable upon receipt and delinquent if not paid by due date.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. As designated on rate schedule regularly applicable.
2. The entire residential service, including space heating service, must be taken through a single meter.
3. All heaters larger than 1,650 watts shall be designated to operate at 240 volts.

4. No individual thermostat or other switching device shall have a connected load in excess of ten (10) kilowatts unless such installation is specifically approved by the District.
5. The District cannot assume responsibility for the installation or operation of the Applicant's space heating equipment nor can the District assume any responsibility with respect to the Applicant's premises such as the insulation of the area to be heated. The District will, however, offer such advisory assistance and recommendations as desired by the Applicant in order to provide the Applicant with the District's suggestions for the most economical installation.
