URBAN COMMERCIAL ELECTRIC SPACE HEATING

AVAILABLE: In the lease towns of Hadar, Clearwater, Elgin and Ewing served by the District.

APPLICABLE: To any commercial Customer when all of Customer's service at one location meets the following requirements.

1. Service is measured by one meter.
2. Electricity is the primary (greater than 50%) source of energy for space heating.
3. The Customer's average monthly kWh is less than 4000 kWh.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE: AC, 60 hertz, single-phase or three-phase, at any of the District's standard primary and secondary voltages.

FACILITIES CHARGE: Single Phase \$24.00 per month
Three Phase \$37.00 per month

DEMAND CHARGE: \$1.00 per KW

ENERGY CHARGE: Winter-October 1st to May 31st
Summer-June 1st to September 30th

The above rates are subject to the Gross Revenue Tax, Lease payment, and Sales Tax as applicable.

Gross Revenue Tax is paid to the County.

Lease Payment is made to the Village or City.

Sales Tax is paid to the State and/or Village or City.

MINIMUM BILL: Facilities Charge

TERMS OF PAYMENT: Bills are due and payable upon receipt and delinquent if not paid by due date.

URBAN COMMERCIAL ELECTRIC SPACE HEATING

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The entire commercial service including space heating service must be taken through a single meter.
2. All heaters larger than 1,650 watts shall be designated to operate at 240 volts.
3. No individual thermostat or other switching device shall have a connected load in excess of ten (10) kilowatts unless such installation is specifically approved by the District.
4. The District cannot assume the responsibility for the installation or operation of the customer's space heating equipment nor can the District assume any responsibility with respect to the customer's premises such as the insulation of the area to be heated. The District will, however, offer such advisory assistance and recommendations as desired by the customer in order to provide the customer with the District's suggestions for the most economical installation.

The rates herein provided are subject to modification by the District to reflect wholesale power rate adjustments and other changes in costs to the District after giving notice to the consumers.
